MARK HILL

After taking a BA in History of Art and Architecture, Mark Hill began his career as a porter and Junior Cataloguer at Bonhams, before moving to Sotheby's. He was co-author of the internationally published Collectable Price Guide with Judith Miller from 2002-17. He has published on specialist subjects in 20th century design and decorative arts. Mark Hill has worked with the Antiques Roadshow since 2007 and has co-presented three series on antiques and collecting for BBC2. He has lectured across the world, including at the V&A in London. He presents two lectures for this Study Day:

UNDRESSING ANTIQUES

Mark Hill aims to offer a persuasive introduction to buying antiques and integrating—and using them—in today's homes. The state of the antiques market and the different meanings of the word "value" are considered; we take a look at what current and future generations of collectors are buying, why they are buying it and how they are displaying it.

LEGENDS OF CZECH GLASS

The 1950s–70s saw a renaissance in Czech glass design that re-established a global reputation. From behind the Iron Curtain, skilled designers pushed the boundaries of 20th century glass design and produced unique masterpieces that went on to inspire visually stunning and highly innovative commercial ranges. The designers were rarely named; the designs they produced have typically been forgotten or misattributed. Mark Hill reveals the work of seven influential designers across cut, blown and pressed glass and considers the economic and political context.
